How to turn off the run prompt from Internet Explorer 7.0 & above

(Applies to XP, Vista and Win 7)

After installing Microsoft Internet Explorer Version 7 or above you may get a message that reads:

Open File - Security Warning

The publisher could not be verified. Are you sure you want to run this software?

Name: ccs.exe

Publisher: Unknown Publisher

Type: Application

From: Z:\Vetccs (or some other location)

Run or Cancel buttons

This file does not have a valid digital signature that verifies its publisher. You should only run software from publishers you trust.

You will get that message for any software you attempt to run from a networked drive. This means the prompt will show up on every workstation, but not the server computer.

To shut this off, do the following on each computer:

Go to control panel Select <Internet Options>

On the screen that opens select the <Security tab>

Click on <Local Intranet>

Then click on <Sites>

Then click on <Advanced>

In the box labeled "Add this website to the zone" type the name of the server computer.

After you have done this, click on the <Add> button

Then click <Close> then <OK> Twice

After this you should be able to run applications from the server without being harassed.

Unfortunately you will have to do this on every computer running IE 7 & above.
